

• Constitution and Bylaws •
VI Llama & Alpaca Club

1. The name of the Club is VI Llama & Alpaca Club.
2. The purposes of the Club are to promote the ethical breeding and management practices of sound and healthy llamas and alpacas (together known as the “Lama”) by:
 - 2.1 Education of lama owners by means of reference materials along with additional assistance when possible,
 - 2.2 Social and other activities involving regular meetings and functions incorporating interactive relations with lamas and their fibre,
 - 2.3 Assisting in the marketing and promotion of lamas as a livestock industry,
 - 2.4 Liaising with the national organization the Canadian Llama & Alpaca Association, on issues that directly affect British Columbian llama and alpaca owners at the National and International level.
3. The activities and purposes of the Club shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members and any income, profits or other accretions to the Club shall be used in promoting the purposes of the Club.
4. In the event of the winding-up or dissolution of the Club, all the funds and assets of the Club remaining after the payment or satisfaction of all costs, charges, expenses, debts and liabilities of the Club, shall be given to such organizations that are determined by the members of the Club to have purposes similar to those of the Club.
5. No Director or Officer shall be remunerated for being or acting as a Director or Officer, but a Director or Officer may be reimbursed for all expenses necessarily and reasonably incurred by him or her while engaged in the affairs of the Club.
